



Background & Mission

The End Child Sexual Abuse Foundation (ECSAF), a non-government charitable organization, was founded in November 1998 by Ms. Siao Fong Fong, an award-winning actress and qualified child psychologist / therapist, with a mission to protect youngsters under 18 from sexual abuse.

What is Child Sexual Abuse?

Child Sexual Abuse refers to sexual contact of any kind with a child through deceptive tricks, intimidation, threats, violence; or giving rewards/ recompense.



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Our Work

The sexual abuse of children is something most people neither believe nor talk about, yet the number of reported cases of child sexual abuse (CSA) in Hong Kong is rising. There are more than 50% of CSA cases which would go unreported. If we choose to do nothing about CSA, 1.3 million children in Hong Kong would be at risk.

The good news is that something can be done. This is what we are doing:

1. ECSAF Education Outreach Programs

- Two mobile classrooms tour primary schools to teach children how to protect themselves from sexual abuse
- Innovative sex education tools and techniques for self defense against sexual abuse are brought to secondary schools by trained Education Officers
- English Version for Primary 1 to 3 Sexual-Abuse-Preventive Program has been officially launched
- A new program for mentally handicapped students has been officially launched
- An interactive approach is adopted, with the use of a variety of multimedia equipment and games, to make these education outreach programs an interesting learning experience



2. Family and Public Education

- Through lectures, seminars, carnivals and the media, ECSAF helps society understand the dangers of CSA and protect children from CSA

- Social workers are available to listen to callers and to give information, resources and counselling on matters related to CSA

4. Counselling for Victims, Abusers and their Families

- Psychologists are available to offer expert counselling service to those in need

5. Library Corners

- Two resource-rich Library Corners have been set up in the Shatin Public Library and ECSAF Centre respectively
- Asia's first collection of CSA materials can be accessed in the Library Corners
- The collection in the Library Corners contains all CSA related literature — reference books, research papers, newspaper clippings, CD ROMs and videos

6. Research

- Commission and publish local academic research/survey on the incidences and causes of CSA to raise public awareness on the problem of CSA in Hong Kong
